The South Carolina Teaching Fellows Program administered by CERRA

- + Recruits talented high school students for the teaching profession in SC.
- + Provides up to \$24,000 (up to \$6,000 per year/up to \$5,700 for tuition and board, and \$300 for specific enrichment programs administered by CERRA) in Fellowship funds to pursue a degree leading to initial teacher certification.
- + Includes professional development and enrichment opportunities.
- + Requires graduates to teach in a South Carolina public school one year for every year they participate in the program.
