Tip 1



Dress to Impress

Don't forget that a virtual interview is still an interview.

- Solid colors look better on camera, while shapes and lines draw attention away from your face.
- Dress and groom as if your interview were in person.





Choose A Great Space

Your space matters.

- Find a space that has **good lighting**. Natural light from a window looks better on camera, but a lamp will do.
- Find a space away from noises and distractions.

Tip 3



Eliminate Background Distractions

Using a virtual background is great.

- Avoid a cluttered space with clothes and other objects behind you.
- Move away from busy areas with traffic.

Tip 4



Check Your Connection

Your internet connection is important.

- Check your internet strength and connection before your interview.
- Check your camera and microphone
- settings to make sure they are working.
 Use a desktop computer, laptop, or stationary device to eliminate issues with your camera moving.
